represent a long and difficult 'intellectual work'. The project was found useful by many experts around the world, the negative comments of the World Bank are not significant in comparison to the many positive comments. And the remark on the 'retirement limit' at 65 is followed by a great number of leaders already.

So this 'intellectual work' must be 'protected' and the credit given to the person who has made all the effort to explain this, Mr. Idris could talked about this better than me, I am sure. There are no difference between the intellectual work necessary to find a vaccine for a grave disease and the intellectual work necessary to understand and explain why continuing to work as leader of a country or an IO after 65 is bad for the world. Both are very important for the entire planet. Likewise presenting a solution to the problem statistical data integration and transfer widely accepted by many experts is beneficial for everyone.

These two proposals are also linked. One is a solution to a complicated technical problem and the other is a solution to a (not so obvious) linked management (governance) problem. They demonstrate that I understand your problems and can bring you solutions.
